

MAN SimplePay cooperates with payment service provider LOGPAY: Contactless payment from the truck in the future

Together with LOGPAY's digital infrastructure in the areas of payment, refueling and tolls, MAN is making the truck payment-capable: The new MAN SimplePay digital platform makes all payment processes easier for drivers - with complete transparency. True to the motto: "Simplifying your business".

- MAN SimplePay automates payment processes
- IN-CAR-PAYMENT: Refueling and paying at the truck
- Expansion into a "payment ecosystem" planned

MAN Truck & Bus is a "smart innovator" and is the first OEM to develop a digital platform for all payment processes relating to commercial vehicles: With MAN SimplePay, the truck becomes a digital wallet for all transactions that arise in everyday trucking.

The advantages of SimplePay: complete transparency and simplification of all payment processes. True to the strategic guiding principle of "Simplifying your Business", MAN Truck & Bus will be simplifying its customers' business in cooperation with LOGPAY from 2023. The SimplePay platform will be expanded to include tolls and will also benefit from the payment service provider's growing MOBILE FUELING acceptance network across Europe. This enables drivers to pay for their fuel conveniently via cell phone without having to enter the petrol station store.

LOGPAY and MAN agreed this strategic cooperation at the IAA Commercial Vehicles 2022. The obvious reasons for this are LOGPAY's affiliation with the Group as a driver of vehicle-based payment innovations and the existing partnership with the MAN Card, which is already established on the market.

The integration for VAN FUELING is also planned for 2023. This means that MAN Cards with SimplePay can then also be used directly in the vehicle and LOGPAY's extensive MOBILE FUELING acceptance network will be activated.

Following the joint demonstration of the IN-CAR-PAYMENT solution at the IAA Commercial Vehicles 2022 and the UNITI Mobility Payment Forum 2022 in a TGE VAN, the implementation of IN-CAR-PAYMENT in the truck is the next important step for both sides.

From a purely technical perspective, MAN uses the MOBILE FUELING and PSP APIs already established by LOGPAY within the SimplePay platform in a shared cloud and makes them available to the driver via MAN's own driver information system. The cloud connection is made via the RIO Box, already installed in the vehicle by MAN.

For example, the LOGPAY PSP API is also part of the apps of many German transport companies for processing various payment methods in the public transport sector.

MAN SimplePay is to be launched on the market as quickly as possible, and with it the expansion of the partner network and services for simple and secure payment. For example, for services on the road - such as a payment guarantee to the workshop via RIO Box in the event of a breakdown or the payment of a workshop invoice via the vehicle and the directly connected portal of the transport company.

MAN SimplePay is already available for pilot customers in the UK market, followed by the launch on the German market. MAN SimplePay will later be implemented internationally beyond Germany's borders. There are also plans to integrate mixed fleets across the TRATON Group and to expand the solution for MAN buses and vans.
