The prerequisite for use is a PLUG&CHARGE-enabled vehicle, such as the VW ID.4 or Audi Q4 e-tron/Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron\*. Customers can conveniently and quickly charge their vehicles at 4,000 charging points throughout Europe. PLUG&CHARGE-enabled charging stations can be found quickly using the convenient filter option in the CHARGE&FUEL app, and the navigation to them can be started straight from the app. Among others, this includes all IONITY charging stations.
